Goran Milicevic is very experienced with youngsters and holds the international title of FIDE Master. Goran participated in various tournaments in Canada with great success. In 1994 he was the Metro Toronto Champion. He has coached many successful Canadian Junior players. Many of his students are Canadian and Ontario Champions by grades and represented Canada on International level.

Goran has taught children how to play the “King of Games” at several schools: Havergal College, York, Toronto French, Bayview Glen, Allenby, Summit Heights, Armour Heights, Bedford Park, People’s Christian Academy, e.g.

Natalia Khoudgarian is Canada’s Woman Chess Champion 2006-2009. She represented Canada at Women’s Olympiads in 1996-Armenia (2nd board), in 2006-Italy (1st board) and in 2008-Germany (1st board).. In 2006 she played at Women’s World Championship in Yekaterinburg.

Children will learn chess in an easy and enjoyable manner in a group of 12-14 students. Trainer will teach basic moves, play development and strategies in step with skills and experience of each child. Each lesson is followed by a practice period.

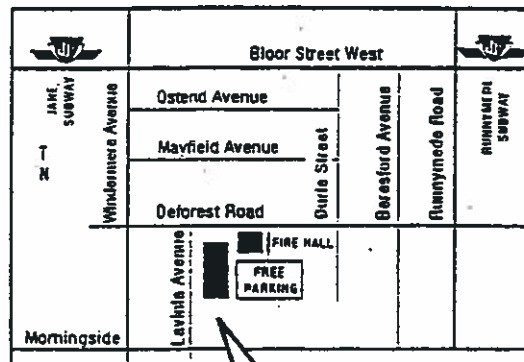
